Re: Citywide Curfew Extended to June 7<sup>th</sup> from 8PM to 5am

Due to the continued looting taking place by agitators who have joined the protest of the murder of George Floyd under false pretenses, the city has decided to extend the curfew through Sunday June 7<sup>th</sup>, from 8pm until 5am. The curfew is scheduled to end just prior to the anticipated June 8<sup>th</sup> Phase I “reopening” of the city. Essential workers will continue to be exempt from the curfew mandate, as well as any individuals seeking medical assistance.

We are doing all we can are working with all building staff and security to ensure your wellbeing and protect the property. We strongly urge you to avoid leaving the building unless it is absolutely necessary. Please work with your concierge, doorman or building staff to ensure your safety e.g. using side exit, walking dogs etc. If you do plan on going out, we urge to continue practicing CDC/DOH and governmental mandated protocols with respect to the use of face coverings/ masks and social distancing.

Considering the ongoing COVID-19 precautions being coordinated by your building staff, please note that the building staff has gone above and beyond to keep the protestors from causing any sort of mayhem or damages on the property.

We will continue to take every precaution to ensure the safety and health of all residents and essential building staff and will provide you with further guidance as the situation evolves.
