Re: Governor Cuomo Signs Executive Order to Ensure All New Yorkers Can Vote While Social Distancing

Please be advised, in light of the ongoing pandemic and social distancing protocols, Governor Cuomo announced during today's April 24, 2020 Daily Briefing, that he will be signing an Executive Order directing the New York State Board of Elections to automatically mail all [eligible/registered] New Yorkers a "postage-paid" application for an absentee ballot .



Earlier this month, the governor issued an Executive Order (E.O. 202.15) allowing all New Yorkers to vote absentee in the upcoming June 23, 2020 primary election. The original April 28th primary date was rescheduled to June 23, 2020 in the Governor's earlier Executive Orders 202.12 and 202.13.

"We're making great progress to flatten the curve and decrease the spread of infection, but we don't know when this pandemic will end and we can't put democracy on hold," Governor Cuomo said. "I am issuing an Executive Order to ensure every New York voter automatically receives a postage-paid application for an absentee ballot because no New Yorker should have to choose between their health and their right to vote."
